

Plein Air Watercolor Workshop with Zina Umyrn

Zina's suggested supplies:

1. Tripod plein air watercolor easel. I like working standing up.

OR small folding table to use for your painting supplies.

You can prop a board on it, or prop it on your lap.

I've done that many times! OR bring a crate with you.

A hand towel on you lap comes in handy.

2. Folding stool or chair

3. Palette:

You can load your paints on a small butcher tray

OR load your paints on a small folding palette that opens up with areas to make your puddles. Either configuration works.

4. Water container. Also always nice to have or share a gallon of clean water! We want to keep our colors vibrant!

5. Spray bottle, masking or artist's tape, paper towels, large clips

6. Suggested paints:

Aureolin yellow, Yellow Ochre, Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue

Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Teal, Sap Green, Perylene Green,

Raw Umber, Burnt Umber

By all means bring a few of your 'Go To' colors!

7. Brushes:

I'm bringing brushes that I use often:

#12 long round #8 round #4 round 1/2" OR 1/4" flat #4 liner

8. Paper:

I like working on 140lb Arches. 100% rag is preferred

9x12 block or sheet attached to foam core or cardboard with

artist's tape

Bring a few extra sheets with you

Have a strip of the same to use as a tester for your colors

9. Hat, sunscreen, bug spray, water & lunch.
